

Bob Long, Board Member, FCM Standing Committee on Environmental Issues and Sustainable Development (and Councillor, Township of Langley)

Re-elected in 2014, Bob Long is currently serving his sixth consecutive term as a Councillor with the Township of Langley. Bob runs a successful restaurant, Bob's Steakhouse, in Aldergrove with his wife Karen in addition to operating Mainstage Productions - a stage, light, and sound production company. His early career was in the newspaper and publishing sector – having founded a community weekly newspaper at the age of 21 and joining Trinity Western University as manager of the university press in 1986. In 1990, he started a commercial printing company in Langley called University Printers Ltd.

Over the years, Bob has served his community through a number of appointments and positions. Current appointments include the Metro Vancouver Zero Waste Committee, the FCM Board of Directors, as well as the Township's Heritage Advisory Committee and Seniors Advisory Committee. Bob sits on the National Zero Waste Council Management Board as one of two seats allocated for members of FCM's Standing Committee on Environmental Issues and Sustainable Development.
