Jacqueline Cramer is Professor of Sustainable Innovation at Utrecht University, a Strategic Advisor at the Utrecht Sustainability Institute, and a Member of the Amsterdam Economic Board with a focus on circular economy implementation. She is presently Chairman of the Plastic Soup Foundation and the ESCo (Energy Service Companies) Netherlands network.
